## I. Introduction 第一部份：簡介

### 1.1 The Centre (CUHK-CLC) 香港中文大學 雅禮中國語文研習所

Founded in 1963 under the joint auspices of New Asia College and the Yale-China Association, the New Asia—Yale-in-China Chinese Language Center (CLC) became part of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) in 1974 and has been responsible for the Chinese language education of CUHK students (both local and international) ever since. In 2009, CLC became part of the Faculty of Arts under the new name “Yale-China Chinese Language Centre”.

CLC provides language training in Cantonese and Putonghua (Mandarin Chinese) to second/ foreign language learners and Chinese speakers. CUHK local and non-local undergraduates/ postgraduates and exchange students are served by the University Programme Section of the Centre, while other learners are served by the Continuing Education Section of the Centre. The main purposes for the CLC’s language courses are to enhance the Chinese language proficiency of students for communication in daily living and for professional purposes. In 2018-19, there were 1000 CUHK students and another thousand expats local and abroad studied CUHK-CLC courses.

新雅中國語文研習所在新亞書院及美國雅禮協會的共同支持下創辦於 1963 年，中大建校後研習所成為大學語言中心，於 1974 年開始為大學學生和國際學生開設華語二語課程（包括普通話和粵語），成為中大開展漢語教育、促進中西文化交流使命的一部分。2009 年歸屬文學院，並以新名稱「雅禮中國語文研習所」繼續為大學服務。

本所為本地及中外學習者提供廣東話和普通話培訓。中大本地及非本地本科生、研究生及交換生課程由本所的大學課程部提供，進修課程由本所的進修課程部提供。本所課程的宗旨為促進學生在日常生活及專業領域中的中國語言溝通能力。在 2015-16 年，本所有一千多名中大學生及一千名中外各行各業人士修讀本所課程。

### B.1 Regular Intensive Daytime Award-bearing Programmes 常規日間密集資歷課程

Applicable to non-native speaking series. Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma Programmes, together with credits carrying option for current university students from abroad are available. In general, class will be held 5 days a week and 3-4 hours per day at CU campus in Shatin. Student intake on every January, June, September. Eligible applicants will be sponsored student visa for their study. 只限外籍 / 外語人士課程 或暑期學院，含證書、文憑、高等文憑或 轉移學分課程。一般每週上課五天，每天日間三至四小時，沙田中大校園上課。逢一、六、九月入學，合資格人士可獲代辦學生簽證入學。

### B.2 Part-time Programmes and Online Courses 兼讀課程及網上課程

Opened to HK residents, the CLC's award-bearing part-time programmes are held on CUHK Shatin campus and conducted online subject to special need. Non-award-bearing short courses are held online and opened to HK and non-HK residents. Courses are divided into two streams namely for non-native speakers and native Chinese speakers. They are usually held at weekday evening or weekend daytime with a frequency to meet 1-2 times and a total of 2-4 hours per week. Student intake in every January, April, May, July, September and October. 研習所的兼讀資歷課程在中大的沙田校園內舉行，歡迎香港居民報讀，會按特殊需要進行網上教學。非資歷的短期課程對所有人士開放（包括非香港居民）。課程分非華語人士和華語人士兩大系列，在平日晚間或週末日間進行，每週上課一至兩天、二至四小時不等，逢一月、四月、五月、七月、九月及十月開課。

### B.3 Summer School 暑期漢語學院

Tailored for those overseas students who wish to study abroad in a Chinese environment during term breaks and to get university credits back to their home schools, these programs are usually in form of intensive daytime study of 4 and 6 weeks (3 to 6 credits), in which a student has sufficient time to build their Chinese proficiency and to explore the unique features of Hong Kong. 特為希望在暑期到海外漢語環境中學習，並取得自己學校認可的學分的外國學生而設。一般為密集型日間課程，為期四至六星期（三至六個學分），學員有足夠的時間在學習中文的同時探索香港。

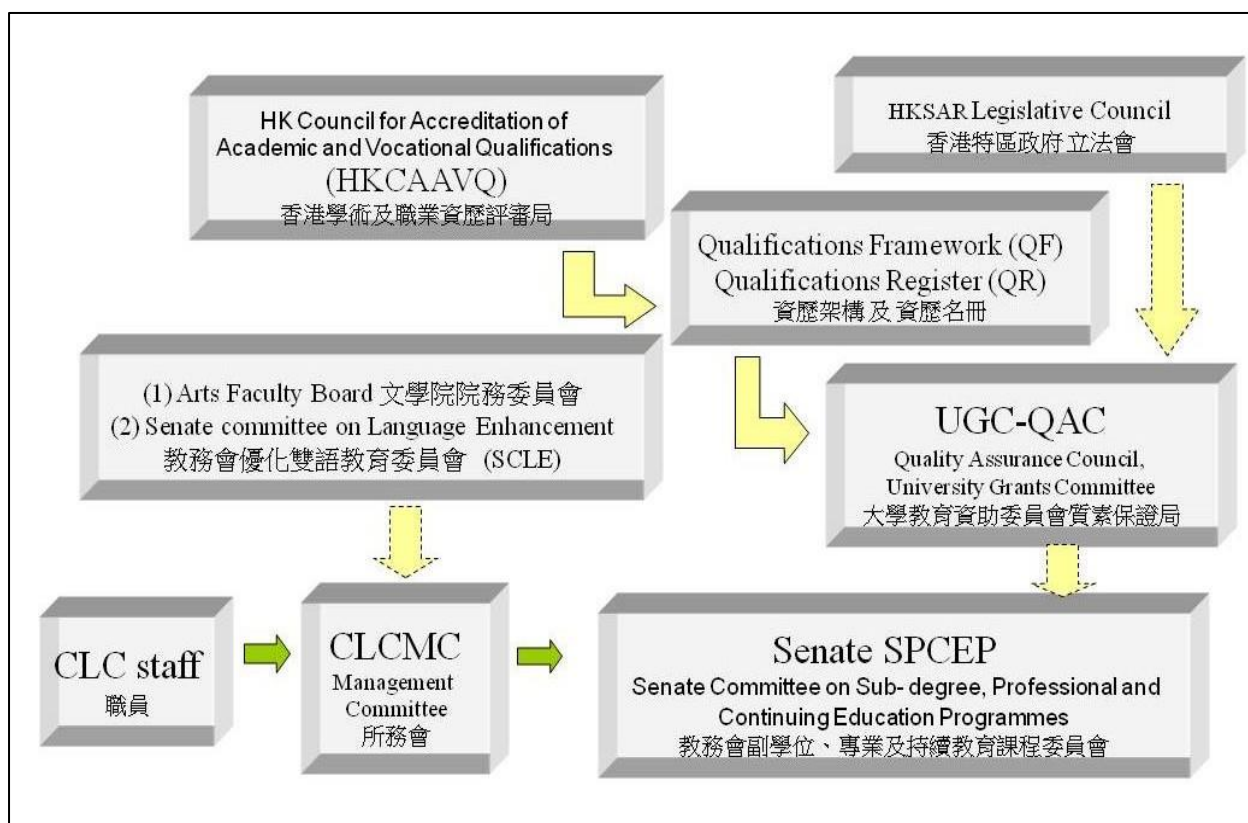

### 2.2 Admission Requirements 入學要求

- (1) Completed Hong Kong secondary five education or equivalent on or prior to 2011 or have completed Hong Kong secondary six education (university admission level) or equivalent on or after 2012. 於 2011 年或之前完成香港中學五年級或同等程度教育；或於 2012 年或之後完成香港中學六年級或同等大學入學程度的教育。
- (2) Non-Hong Kong resident is required by law to apply for student visa for any study in Hong Kong. 非香港居民須根據入境處要求申請學生簽證方能入學；
- (3) For those who apply for non level 1 classes are required to take a placement test. 申請者若報讀非第一級課程須參加分班考試。
- (4) Adolescents between 15 to 17 years old or above, as long as written consent is received from their parents or guardians and there is/ are guardian(s) in Hong Kong, are allowed to join the non-award bearing programmes offered by the Centre. 十五歲至十七歲的青少年，若有家長或監護人簽署同意書，並有監護人在香港居住，可參加本所的

非證書課程。

- (5) It is desirable for applicants to possess functional ability in English to ease learning and living in Hong Kong. However, it is NOT an entry pre-requisite. 英語能力並非入學要求。若申請者能操基礎英語，將有利申請者在港的學習與生活。
- (6) Mid-term admission is only allowed subject to discretion of the division head based on student's level and availability of seat. 中期入學只限組長在考慮學生程度及名額後才獲批准。
- (7) The Centre reserves the full right of student admission and requirement, including the right of refusing a student's application. 本所保留一切收生的準則及權利，有權拒絕學員的申請。

## 2.3 Major Fees & Refund Policy 主要款項及退款條款

### 2.3.1 Major Fees 主要費用

#### 2.3.1.1 Application Fee 申請費

Application fees are not refundable. If a student, for any unforeseen reasons, cannot report to the Centre for the term he/she has been accepted, he/she may apply in writing for postponement of studies. Such an application should reach the CLC two weeks before the term begins and the postponement should not be for more than one year. A student may apply only once for postponement of studies.

按大學慣例報名費不能退還。已被錄取的學生如申請延期入學，必須書面提出並於開學前兩星期送達辦公室，延期不可超過一年，且只可申請一次。

#### 2.3.1.2 Deposit 按金

- A deposit of \$1,600 is charged on all applicants to secure a place in the class, to be paid upon application. Those who aim at pursuing higher academic awards, whether or not they will take breaks during semesters, should not withdraw the deposit. Otherwise, they will be treated as discontinuing the programme. The credits they earned before could not be accumulated for future higher awards. For details about award-bearing awards, please refer to item 6.4.2. 學生申請入學時需繳交 1,600 元按金留位。若學生有志進修達至更高程度，不論中途會否休學一至數個學期，應避免提取按金，否則當退學論，學生不能為日後獲取更高級別的資歷而累積學分。關於獲得資歷證書的資格詳參 6.4.2
- The deposit will be held as caution money while the student remains a bona fide student at the CLC, and will be refunded upon the termination of studies at CLC. 學生入學後按金將轉作保證金，可於學生退學時發還。
- Deposit will not be refunded upon several conditions, please refer section 2.3.2 on refund policy. 按金在 2.3.2 項所示的情況下將不獲發還。
- In addition section 2.3.2, if a student fails to return or damages any borrowed materials (books, tapes, etc.) upon leaving the Centre at the end of studies, deposit will not be refunded. 除 2.3.2 項所述外，學生若離校前未退還或損毀了借用的物件(如書本、錄音帶等)，按金將不獲退還。
- Unclaimed deposits will be remitted to the University's central account three years after a student leaves the Centre (to be calculated from the last day of the last semester

#### 2.3.1.3 Tuition 學費

Tuition fees must be paid by new and incoming students on or before Registration Day. Continuing students should pay tuition fees on or before the date specified by the Centre unless prior permission for deferment has been obtained from the Director. Tuition payments are to be paid in full at the designated time and CLC does not accept partial payment. A student paying in arrears is subject to fines. (See section 2.3.2 for refund policy).

Students are required to pay tuition trimester by trimester. No prepayment for more than 1 school term is allowed.

(2) One should aware of the visa consequence if it is sponsored by CUHK-CLC, in which it is only given to students who study 12 or more credits in a school term. (3) For students who have prepaid tuition fees, please refer to the signed student regulations and/ or tuition prepayment agreement. Penalty/ handling charge exists on ALL prepaid tuition upon course withdrawal.
4. Reminder to student visa holders: (1) Re-enrolling students seeking student visa sponsorship extension must settle the tuition fee of the next term first before the Centre can issue supporting document. Successful renewal of student visa normally takes 3 to 4 weeks and the HK Immigration requires students to renew visa in person at their office.

The following identity or Hong Kong visa holders are eligible to study CLC programmes:

(1) HK Permanent ID Card, (2) HK Study Visa (only those sponsored by CUHK-CLC, or otherwise written permission is needed from IMMD and the original sponsoring school), (3) HK Employment Visa, (4) HK Working Holiday Visa, (5) HK Dependant Visa, (6) HK Training Visa (prior approval must be sought from trainer and IMMD)

HK tourist visa and HK visa exemption status are not allowed to study in HK. The public health care services in local rates are not applicable to these statuses. 香港旅遊簽證及免旅遊簽證身份不能在港進修，也不能以本地人價格享用香港公立醫療服務。

Student visa, once activated, is entitled to multiple entries into Hong Kong within the specified period. The normal student visa expiry date is 1 week after the final exam day of the paid school term for new students and re-enrolled students, and the day of make-up examination of a paid school term for students who change visa status or sponsoring school. 學生簽證生效後便可在指定期限多次出入香港。學生簽證一般到期日為已付費學期的期末考試後的一個星期（新生及續讀生）及已付費學期的補考日期（轉簽證及轉院校擔保的人士）。

CUHKCLC is not responsible for any tuition fee refund nor loss of a student as a result of late application, late payment, late visa application and late visa extension. 研習所不會因學生在辦理入學手續、付款、申請簽證或延長簽證上的延誤而承擔退學費等責任。

Working visa holiday holder should pay attention to the fact that the study duration entitlement is different from nationality to nationality and not correspond to the visa expiry date. For more information, please check HK Immigration web site at:

Students should make sure that their HK visas are valid and have not expired when they return to Hong Kong after touring outside Hong Kong or from a return trip to their home countries. In that case, the students will be re-entering Hong Kong using visa-exempted tourist status instead of student status, and will not be allowed to resume the study in Hong Kong. The student has to activate the renewed study visa by leaving Hong Kong once again. THIS APPLIES TO TRIPS TO MACAU AND SHENZHEN AS WELL. 學生若要離開香港旅遊或回國時，必須注意香港簽證是否過期，否則香港入境事務處有權拒絕該名學生再度入境繼續學習。此情況亦適用於往澳門及深圳旅遊。

“Relaxation of employment restriction for non-local students” and “Immigration arrangement for non-local graduates” are not applicable to language study students/ graduates. “Quality Migrant Admission Scheme” has quota and applicant’s language ability is only one of the many criteria in the successful application of the scheme. Visa applicants are advised to adjust their expectation based on the latest IMMD policy.

- (applicable to CLC student visa holder) Any new students who are currently in Hong Kong and all continuing students are required by the HKSAR Immigration Department to process study visa application or study visa extension in person at the immigration office. Tourist status is not allowed to study in Hong Kong unless it is changed into student status by applying for a study visa, or to some other eligible visa status. - Students who aim at Advanced Diploma Award (A.Dip) should plan carefully the schedule for taking the graduation examination. - Continuing students, upon paying of tuition fee, should mention the request of study visa extension if they need one. - Continuing students who procrastinate study visa extension application due to delayed tuition fee settlement will not be allowed to join the class even if school term starts. - Students with visas sponsored by the Centre whose unexcused absences have accumulated to more than 30% of the total enrolled class hours shall be considered as having withdrawn from studies at the Centre. There will be no refund of any fees paid and said student shall receive an "F" grade for the course. 由本所擔保的學生缺席如累積超過該學期課時數的 30% 將被視作退學處理，任何已付的費用將不退還，而學生將獲 “F” 等級成績。

## 2.5 Student Conduct 學生操守

### 2.5.1. Attendance Check 檢查出席率

Teachers check attendance for each session in class. As stipulated by the board policy, attendance below 70% in each semester will not be eligible to CUHK-CLC awards. Serious absence will result in score adjustment and losing visa sponsorship by CUHKCLC, if any. 老師上每一節課時點名。按照本所章程規定，學員上課次數不得少於全學期課程之七成。出席次數不足之學員不論考試及格與否，將不獲發給任何證明。同時，缺席嚴重者將失去本所贊助之學生簽證。

### 2.5.2 Leave 請假

- A student who cannot attend classes because of medical or other reasons shall, prior to the absence, complete a Leave Application Form available at the front counter indicating the exact date(s) of his/her absence and return the completed form to the Class Coordinator or DH. If this is not possible, a student shall complete the Leave Application Form within two days after returning to school and return the completed form to the Class Coordinator/ DH. Otherwise, the leave shall be treated as unexcused. Serious absence will affect the student's grade and visa sponsorship, if any. 學生由於健康或其他理由未能上課應於缺席前或缺席後兩天內填寫請假申請表交給班導師或組長，否則作曠課論。嚴重缺席會影響學生的成績等級。
- A student who wishes to obtain a leave of absence for more than 9 sessions for non-medical reasons shall make request in writing to the DH beforehand, stating the reasons for which leave of absence is sought. 若非因健康理由，學生請假 9 節課以上須事先以書面向組長申請，並在信上說明理由。
- For sick leave of two days or more, CLC may require the student to submit a certificate signed by a registered medical practitioner. Under unusual circumstances, however, a special case may be considered on individual merit. 本所可要求請病假兩天或以上的學生提交醫生證明。個別特殊情況本所或另作考慮。
- Reminder will be issued to students (1) whose unexcused leave has exceeded 9 sessions. (2) Accumulated leave of absence exceeds 1/4 of the scheduled teaching sessions of a term. 本所在以下情況將發出備忘信予學生：(1) 無理由請假超過九課時；(2) 缺席超過當學期課時數四分之一。

- Students with visas sponsored by CUHKCLC ~~whose accumulated~~ leave of absence (sick leave plus leave of non-medical) exceeds 1/4 of the scheduled teaching sessions of a term will be receiving a warning letter. 本所擔保簽證的學生，若累積缺課（包括病假及事假）超過該學期課時數的四分之一，將收到本所發出的警告信。
- When a student whose accumulated leave of absence exceeds 1/3 of the scheduled teaching sessions of a term will be required to withdraw from the Centre. His/ her student visa sponsorship, if any, will be forfeited. 由本所擔保學生簽證的學生如缺席（病假及事假）累積超過學期上課時數的三分之一將被要求退學。

### 2.5.3 Discontinuation of Studies 強制退學

A student shall be required to discontinue his studies at the Centre if his grade point average in a term is below “1.0” (D) for two consecutive terms of attendance. 學生連續兩學期每學期平均積點均在 1.0 (D) 以下，須自本校退學。

The Director of CUHKCLC reserves the right to dismiss a student for academic or other reasons at any time during a term without refund of any fees paid. Clearly that this is an extreme action that is taken in cases of egregious conduct lapses or when students have seriously violated the CUHK's conduct regulations. 對於嚴重違反中大守則的學生，本所所長保留開除該學生學籍之權利。

### 2.5.4 Smoking 吸煙

Under the Smoking (Public health) (Amendment) Ordinance (Cap. 371), the entire campus of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (including indoor and outdoor areas) has been designated as no smoking area with effect from January 1, 2007. The Chinese University of Hong Kong is committed to maintaining a smoke-free campus. #### **2.5.11 No unauthorized personnel in class 禁止非許可人士上課**

Any personnel who did not complete the application procedure; who did not fulfill immigration requirement; or did not settle the fee properly is not allowed to take part in any lesson held by CLC. Friends and relatives of students are not allowed to sit in the class unless they are properly registered. Pets are not allowed in class. 未完成入學程序、未符合入境留學條件及未完成付款的學生一律禁止上課。本所亦謝絕未完成入學程序的學生家屬或朋友參與課程。禁止攜帶寵物上課。

#### **2.5.12 Unauthorized material distribution and sale activity 未被授權分發材料及銷售活動**

Any distribution of unauthorized questionnaires, brochures, publicities etc has to seek prior approval in writing from the Centre. Students can only fill in the questionnaires on voluntary basis. For approved unofficial questionnaires and interviews, the Centre will post out notice allowing students to make contact directly to the individual or party concerned. The Centre does not allow attempt to wait or to approach students in the CLC premises for research and selling activities. 在研習所範圍向學生派發任何問卷或宣傳品都必須書面向本所申請。學生必須在自願的情況下做問卷。對於獲批准的問卷申請，本所只能安排張貼通告，由學生直接聯絡問卷負責人。所務會不容許在研習所範圍等候，主動接觸學生做研究或推銷。

#### **2.5.13 Student Disciplinary Action 學生紀律行動**

The Chinese University of Hong Kong has adopted a set of procedures for handling student disciplinary cases, as part of the process of helping and educating students who may have violated any rules/ regulations of the University or who may have committed any misconduct, so as to make them realize and correct any mistakes.

Disciplinary action may result in a penalty in any one or more of the following forms: (a) suspension from part or all of the rights, privileges and/or the use of part or all of the facilities of the Centre/ University for a specified period of time; (b) suspension from the University for a specified period of time; (c) termination of student visa sponsorship. (d) termination of studies at the University; (e) any other form as the disciplinary committees (as the case may be) may deem fit.

香港中文大學確立程序，處理學生的紀律個案，作為協助和教育過程的一部份，使違犯大學任何規則 / 條例或行為不當的學生瞭解及糾正錯誤。

處分可屬下列任何一種或多種形式：(1) 在指定期限內，停止享有部分或全部在研習所/中大的權益，及 / 或停止使用部分或全部學校設備；(2) 著令於指定期限內暫行休學；(3) 取消留學簽證擔保；(4) 開除學籍；(5) 紀律委員會(視情況而定)認為合適的任何其他形式。

### **III. Course and Lesson Arrangement 第三部份：課程安排**

Any new announcement will be made by your teacher, course coordinator or at CLC web

site. 新公佈將通過老師、課程統籌或本所網頁發放。

### 3.1 Weekly Class Schedules 每週上課時間表

(Daytime intensive award-bearing programmes only 只限日間密集課程)

In contrast to one instructor being responsible for one class, a rotational teaching system is used in the Regular daytime intensive programmes to expose students to different individual styles of standard speech from different teachers. Each level is assigned a Coordinator (a teacher) who keeps supervisory control and provides academic advice to students.

本所常規日間課程採用輪教制度，讓學生接觸標準語的不同導師的表達方式。每級別都有一位統籌導師負責幫助學生解決學習上的問題。

Cantonese class schedule for the whole school term would be distributed during the first week of class or/ and orientation.

該學期的廣東話課表將在學期第一週課上或迎新時派發。

Putonghua weekly class schedules for the whole school term would be distributed during the first week of class or/ and orientation.

該學期的普通話課表將在學期第一週課上或迎新時派發。

### 3.2 Putonghua and Cantonese Programme Options 普通話及廣東話課程選擇

CUHKCLC does not recommend students to study both Putonghua and Cantonese Programme at the same time unless one dialect is at least 3 levels higher than the other. Otherwise, students will experience severe language interference in the learning. Putonghua students intended for level one to three must study the full programme (15 credits) in order to get admitted. Those who cannot afford the study can consider Centre's part-time programme. 本所不鼓勵學生同時修讀普通話及廣東話，除非其中一個方言比另一種程度高至少三級，否則學生在學習的過程將經歷嚴重的語言混淆。另一方面，第一至三級普通話常規課程只接受完整課程（十五學分）的申請，學生若不能修讀此學分數目請考慮本所的兼讀課程。

### 3.3 Morning class and afternoon class option 上午課及下午課選擇

Due to teacher and classroom availability, classes may be scheduled for morning or afternoon. If a class has both morning and afternoon options, Hong Kong residents who usually have family and work commitment are given higher priority to study morning class. Afternoon class is reserved to study visa holders whose purpose in Hong Kong is to study. Study visa holder students can apply for morning class if there is still quota left and allocation of quota by lots drawing. 因老師數目及課室的限制，上課時間可能安排在上午或者下午。如一個班有上午及下午的選擇，上午班將優先提供予有工作及家庭負擔的本地居民，報名先到先得。如上午班尚餘名額，將抽籤分配給申請上午班的留學簽證學生。

### 3.4 Elementary, Intermediate & Advanced Levels 初級、中級及高級程度

Level 1 to 3 teaches students the fundamental skills of Chinese language and equip students

to achieve the basic communication functions using the learned language, namely describing, explaining, illustrating, discussing and offering information. In other words, level 1 to 3 can be called the foundation stage of a language acquisition. This part takes around 600 hours. The more time and effort the students are willing to spend in building up a good foundation in these levels, the more beneficial to the students in their upcoming advanced level study in the Chinese Language.

第一至第三級教導漢語基礎，學生可完成描述、說明、解釋、討論及提供資訊等語言任務。換句話說，第一至第三班為中文學習打下基礎，大約需要六百小時。學生若願意在此階段多花功夫，對他／她將來的學習將有所裨益。

Any study above level 3, is called the “advanced level” in the Centre. The purpose of the lesson will focus on how to use the Chinese language appropriately and freely, and to expand to higher level language functions, such as analyzing, comparing and contrasting, expounding, narrating, suggesting, complaining, refusing, promoting, apologizing, criticizing and more formal introduction. An Advanced Diploma candidate should be able to complete some of the following advanced language tasks, such as expressing an opinion, speaking at meetings, expressing thanks in public, persuading, rebutting, congratulating, delivering a speech, defending, calling to action and formal introduction. Students are expected to take more initiatives to expose and immerse themselves to the language. They should not be passive and expect the teachers to feed them all the language knowledge. If a student’s foundation is not good enough, he/ she will encounter tremendous difficulty in their advanced level study.

第三班以上的研修在本所統稱「高等程度」或「高班」。課程目的集中在如何自由、得體地使用漢語，發展更高層次的語言技能如：分析、比較、闡釋、陳述、建議、投訴、拒絕、推銷、致歉、批評及較正式的介紹等。獲得對外漢語高等文憑準畢業生應可完成部份以下更高層次任務，包括：發表見解、會議發言、公開致謝、勸說、反駁、祝賀、演講、辯護、號召及正式介紹。學生應該盡量主動使用所學習的語言，而不是被動地依賴老師灌輸知識。學生若基礎不佳，不應勉強升讀「高等程度」學科。

“Level 4” is regarded as advanced level in the Centre and any additional hours belong to this level. All the courses provided with a prefix “4” (e.g. CLCP/ CPTH4xxx) connotes advanced level courses. They are offered in a parallel mode in which students can choose freely. 在研習所，「第四班」屬高等程度，任何額外的學習都屬此級別。凡冠以字首“4”的課程編號（如 CLCP/CPTH4xxx），皆表示該課程屬高等程度，該等課程同時推出供高等程度學生自由選擇。

Your corresponding division head will explain to you more if you will be promoting to the advanced level. 所屬組長將給予更多資訊予升讀高等程度科目的同學。

### 3.5 Course Add/ Drop 課程之加退選

Application for course add/ drop shall be made in writing (forms provided by the Centre) to the Division Head with validation from the general office before add/ drop deadline of a school term. The add/ drop period is normally the first 5 working days after term start. For the exact date, please refer to the school calendar: [www.cuhk.edu.hk/clc/clccalendar.pdf](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/clc/clccalendar.pdf)

Dropping a course during add/ drop period will be subject to a handling charge. Strictly no add/ drop and refund request will be entertained after add/ drop deadline. Students whose visa is sponsored by the Centre should take heed that excessive drop of courses fail to comply with the “student” status as required by the HK Immigration, and will result in student visa sponsorship withdrawal. 學生若要加選或退選課程，必須在加退選期限內書面向組長提出，並由辦公室核對作實（本所提供表格）。加退選期通常是開學後首五個工作日，確實日期請參校曆，網址：[www.cuhk.edu.hk/clc/clccalendar.pdf](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/clc/clccalendar.pdf)。在加退選週退選將徵收手續費，在加退選期後退選或要求退款將不獲考慮。由本所擔保簽證的學生，必須留意退選過多科目將不符合入境處要求的「學生」身份，將引致本所撤回簽證擔保。

### 3.6 Course Deferral Application 延期上課申請

Application for course deferral is only accepted during or before add/ drop period. Application of course deferral after add/ drop period is strictly not allowed. Handling charge similar to course withdrawal will be practiced with reference to the refund policy as shown in 2.3.2. In case a tuition fee is deferred to a term charging a different tuition rate, the excessive tuition fee will not be refunded. On the opposite case, student have to pay the tuition fee shortfall, if any. 延期上課申請只限在加退選期內或之前，加退選期過後一律不接受上課延期之申請。申請延期亦會產生手續費，詳參 2.3.2. 退款守則。若學費延期至收取不同學費額的學期或班級，多交部分將不獲退還，少交部分將補償差額。

### 3.7 Programme Transfer 課程轉修

Most courses provided by the Centre are components of various award-bearing programmes. All students are required to indicate their intended programme on the application form upon admission. Students can refer to the website for programme requirement, course components and study path. If there is any change on the study plan which result in a change of programme different from the one indicated on the application form, the student should submit a programme transfer application form. Approval is subject to the evaluation of the teaching division head. 本所提供的大部份科目都是資歷課程的一部份，所有學生均須在申請入學時在報名表上注明欲報讀的資歷課程。學生可到本所網頁瀏覽課程要求、科目構成及研修路徑。如學生想更改研修計劃而導致資歷課程與報名時的不一樣，學生須提交課程轉修申請表，由教學組長評估後批准。

### 3.8 Course Changes and Cancellation 課程更改及取消

CLC reserves the right to cancel a course if enrolment is insufficient, and to make alterations in light of operation reality in the instructor assignment, class location, class schedule and the content of the courses. 本所保留在報名人數不足時取消課程或修改授課方式的權利，並可能按實際運作情況更改導師分配、上課時間、地點及課程內容。

### 3.9 Non-credit Grade Options 選擇非學分制

CLC students whose visas are not sponsored by the Centre can apply to take a course on a non-credit basis before the end of each term. Whether students exercising this option are allowed to advance to the next higher level is fully depending on the instructor's assessment. 不需本所擔保學生簽證的學生可於學期結束前申請非學分制。作此選擇的學生是否可繼續修讀更高程度的科目將取決於導師的評估。

### 3.10 Course retake 重修學科

Students who pass a subject and want to retake the subject is allowed based on the following condition: (1) study credit is only counted once and the best grade out of the school terms will be counted (except for advanced level courses which use different teaching materials for the same course). (2) If a student fails in a subject, only a one-time retake is allowed. (3) Only credits earned from the most recent 3 years will be counted toward the academic award. (4) If visa sponsorship is not needed and the student passed the course assessment, the number of times for course retake is not limited. (5) For student visa sponsored students, the maximum study length should not exceed 9 school terms. 學生在及格的情況下按下原則容許重讀：(1) 只算一個學期的學分(成績比較好的一個學期)，除非是用不同教材的高班課。(2) 若不及格，最多重讀一次。(3) 拿證書只算最近三年內的學分。(4) 若無簽證問題及通過科目評核，重讀次數沒有限制。(5) 簽證擔保的學生最多唸九個學期。

### 3.11 Maximum study load 修課量上限

As long as there is no time conflict, students are given automatic consent to study as many as 21 credits per school term. For study across divisions/ languages, prior approval from the

head of each division is necessary. Study load exceeding 21 credits has to seek approval from the division head. 只要時間沒有衝突，學生可選擇每學期修讀不超過21 學分的課程。若是跨組修讀，必須獲兩組組長同意。修課量多過 21 學分須獲組長批准。

### 3.12 Student Mix 學生組合

CLC's Chinese as a foreign/ second language classes are usually composed of students from different countries, with a wide age range, of different cultures, languages, religions, occupations, education and family backgrounds. CLC as a teaching unit of CUHK always do our best to provide a harmonious learning atmosphere for all our students in such a diversity, which is not easy, but achievable if all students respect other's culture as our own. Students are encouraged to reach your teacher and the division head in case there is any feedback. 研習所對外漢語課程的學生多來自不同的國家，年齡分佈較廣，文化、宗教、職業、教育及家庭背景都較多樣化。研習所身為中大的教學部門，努力為學生創造和諧的學習環境，我們需要每一位學生積極配合，互相尊重。學生如有問題，可先向老師或組長反映。

### 3.13 Course Questionnaires and End-of-term Planning Form 課程問卷及動向表

Students are free to express their views about the programme in form of questionnaires given twice in a school term, around mid-term and at the end of each school term respectively. These questionnaires will be analyzed and studied seriously as a mean of programme quality control. 每個學期學生會被邀請通過問卷自由表達意見，問卷分別在中期及期末時發出，有助本所改善課程。

A end-of-term planning form (formerly known as re-enrolment form) will be given to students by the end of each school term. All students should fill in and return the form for

(i) course re-enrolment for the next school term for continuing students or (ii) deposit refund and grade report pick up instruction for leaving students. 學生將在學期結束前獲發動向表，所有學生必須填寫，以便職員跟進 (i) 續讀學生下學期的科目註冊；(ii) 退學學生的按金退款及領取成績單的方法。

### 3.14 Selling of teaching materials 教材銷售

Major textbooks written by CLC teaching team used among university students and continuing education students have been formally published by Commercial Press Hong Kong. They are now available for sale at CLC counter and major bookstores in Hong Kong. For teaching materials which are still under review, not formally published and can only be used effectively with the guidance in class by trained teachers, they are restricted to enrolled students of the respective division only. 由本所教研團隊編制的大學課程教材及進修課程教材已由香港商務印出版社出版，在本所櫃台及香港主要書店發售。非正式出版的教材只有在受訓老師的指導下使用才能發揮最好的效果，只限屬於該組別的現生購買。

### 3.15 Teacher-on-duty 當值老師

Full-time teachers are assigned duty hours outside teaching to answer queries from students. Duty roster is posted on the bulletin board of your corresponding division. At most 15 minutes per student is allowed per appointment. 全職老師在教學以外安排當值時間，以解答學生的疑問。當值時間表已張貼在學生所屬組別的壁報版上，每位學生每次限十五分鐘面談時間。

### 3.16 Class Audit 聽課安排

To ensure quality of teaching, the Centre conducts regular class audit by division heads, the director and other appointed personnel by CUHK. If your class has been chosen for the audit, please perform the way you used. 為確保教學水準，研習所定期安排組長、所長或中文大學指定人員聽課，若你的課被選中，請如常表現。

### 3.17 Trial lesson and Auditing Students 試讀及旁聽生

All courses in the Centre do not provide trial lesson(s) and will not take in auditing students. All course participants should be the designated teacher(s) and students. 本所課程不設試讀及旁聽，參與課堂者必須為指定的師生。

### 3.18 Audio-visual Recording and Use of Students' Work 影音攝錄及應用學生作業

CLC staff may, from time to time, take photos and conduct sound and video recording during class, activities and assessments. These materials may be used for several purposes such as the academic evaluation of a student's learning, programme evaluation, staff training, teaching-based research and publicity. A student's work within the programme which include but not limited to written assignment, test and exam, maybe used for the above purposes as well (student identity remains confidential). Students who do not agree with the arrangement please feel free to let us know in writing. 本所職員可能在課堂、活動及評估時拍照、錄音或錄像，材料有多種用途包括學術評估、課程評估、教師培訓、教學研究及課程推廣。學生在課程中的書面作業、測驗或考試也有可能作以上用途(學生身份保密)，學生若不同意安排請書面通知本所。

## IV. Course Assessment 第四部份：課程評核

### 4.1 CUHK-CLC Grading System 評分標準

All assessments will be conducted during class hour. Criterion-referenced approach will be used in the grading. Unless otherwise specified, those who absent from the test will receive zero score for that particular test. Regarding make-up examination, please see section V for details. Assessment results of students would be used for teaching-related research.

### 4.2 The Graduation Examination 畢業考試

Permission to attend the Advanced Diploma Graduation Examination will be given to the following candidates: (1) Putonghua students who studied a minimum of 45 credits from level 3 including China PRINCH. (2) Cantonese students who studied a minimum of 45 credits from level 3 including Hong Kong PRINCH and Chinese reading subject(s). The Centre will make invitation to the candidates in due time. The Graduation Examination format may include essay writing, interview, speech presentation and written tests. Students who failed in the graduation exam will be given a one-time make-up exam, which should be taken within two consecutive school terms immediately after the first take of the graduation exam. Diploma award will be given to those who are not able to pass the Graduation Exam. 要獲得應考高等文憑畢業考試的資格，普通話學生必須從最低第三班開始修讀包括中國 PRINCH 在內最少 45 個學分，廣東話學生必須從最低第三班開始修讀包括香港 PRINCH 及中文閱讀科目在內的 45 個學分。合資格的學生將獲得校方通知參加畢業考試。畢業考試內容可包括論文、面試、演說及筆試。未能通過畢業考試的學生可獲一次補考機會，必須於首次應考後兩個連續學期內補考，否則當放棄論，未能通過高等文憑畢業考試的學生將獲發文憑資歷證書。

About certificate issuing please refer to section 6.4.關於發出資歷證書，請參 6.4 項。

### 4.3 Grading System for Putonghua Division 普通話組評分制度

The grade of each course is calculated separately. For details, please refer to the course outlines distributed by the teachers during the first week of class.

每門課成績獨立計算，詳情請參閱學期第一周由老師派發的課程大綱。

#### Note

1. Student must pass the final examination in order to receive the result/ credit for the course. 學生須通過期末考試，方可得到該課程的成績及學分。
2. The grade of each course is calculated separately. 每一門課的成績獨立計算。
3. As a principle, unless with certificate signed by a registered medical practitioner, final marks will be lowered by 1% for absence of 1 hour, and a maximum of 10% can be deducted. 原則上，除非有醫生證明，缺席一節課扣期末總分 1%，上限為 10%。
4. Students are advised to tightly prepare for classes in accordance with the daily schedule and actively participate in all class exercises. One student getting out of pace from the group will affect the entire class progress. 學生在課前務必按照課表充分預習，上課時則要積極參與。學生的個人表現對整班的進度有明顯的影響。

### 4.4 Grading System for Cantonese Division 廣東話組評分制度

#### Final grades calculation 總成績計算方法

Most courses use the following assessment scheme. The grade of each course is calculated separately. For details, please refer to the “student study guidelines” distributed by the teachers. 大部份科目都採用以下辦法計算成績，每一個科目的成績獨立計算，詳情請參閱由老師派發的「學生學習指引」。

#### In-class Participation 課堂參與

Instructors formally assess student progress twice per term based on the following criteria. 每學期平時分根據以下原則而定。

Course Preparation 備課 : The Centre employs rotation teaching system in some of the classes which allows flexible teaching schedules for different language functions. So, students are advised to tightly prepare for classes in accordance with the daily schedule. One student getting out of pace from the group will affect the entire class progress. Instructors evaluate student preparation by determining their grasp of vocabulary and structures, familiarity with lesson content, preparation of reading/writing exercises before class, etc. 本所部份課程採用輪教制，學生必須備課以配合課表進度。由於課堂注重互動，一人落後會影響全班。老師根據學生

對生字句型之掌握、課文內容之熟悉、讀寫或翻譯練習之課前預備而評分。

Use of Language 語言運用: This element in the assessment evaluates the functional use of the language, such as ‘comprehension’, ‘situation’, ‘discussion’, ‘illustration description’, ‘speech’, ‘guided conversation’, ‘newspaper reading and discussion’, etc. 此項評核根據學生在不同課堂的表現而定，例如：聽力理解、情境對話、討論、看圖描述、演講、讀報及討論等。

General Performance 整體表現: Students’ overall approach to studies, include but not limited to active and regular participation in class; whether the student is positive towards programme goals will all be taken into consideration. 授課老師還會按學生在學習方面的積極參與、出席率及學習態度而作出考量。

#### 4.5 Honesty in Academic Work 學術著作誠信

The Chinese University of Hong Kong places very high importance on honesty in academic work submitted by students, and adopts a policy of *zero tolerance* on academic dishonesty. While "academic dishonesty" is the overall name, there are several sub-categories such as plagiarism, undeclared multiple submission, cheating in tests and examinations and all other acts of academic dishonesty. Any related offence will lead to disciplinary action including termination of studies at the Centre.

香港中文大學對學生作業有嚴格的學術誠信要求，違反學術誠信的個案，一律以零容忍政策處理。「違反學術誠信」是一個統稱，包括類別有抄襲、未有聲明重覆使用作業、測驗、考試作弊及所有其他違反學術誠信行為。違反有關規定的學生予以懲處，嚴重者包括開除學籍。

#### 4.6 Grade Appeal 成績覆核

Students who have question on their final grade should consult their course teacher or the general office first within one week after the official announcement of the grade. A student who would like to lodge a grade appeal should fill in a form within 2 weeks from the grade release date and to pay a fee of HK\$500 per 3-credit subject. The work of the student will be reviewed by an examination panel in which the decision, whether an upward or downward change in grade, will be final.

學生若對期末總成績有疑問，請在公佈成績後一週內向任課老師或辦公室查詢。學生如欲正式提出成績覆核，請於公佈成績後兩週內填妥指定表格，並支付費用每三學分科目港幣五百元。學生的考試內容將由一個考核小組重新評核，小組最終的評分（不論是提高或降低）將是定案。

## V. Make-Up Examinations 第五部份：補考

### 5.1. Sick Leave 病假

As long as a valid certification from a recognized medical practitioner can be produced, the make-up oral exam will not be charged extra. For other arrangements such as scoring and scheduling will still follow the usual practice. Please refer to 5.2 and 5.3 below for more information.

### 5.2 Make-up Exams for Putonghua Students 普通話學生補考須知

#### (a) Dictations and Quizzes 聽寫和小測

Dictations and quizzes cannot be made up. The scores for the absent dictations/ quizzes will be zero.

#### (b) Periodical Written Tests, Oral Tests and Presentations 筆試、期中口試及演講

HK\$500 and HK\$300 will be charged respectively for each oral and written exam that is taken in advance or after the designated exam time. Postponed oral and written exams must be completed on the day assigned by the Division Head and will be graded 20% lower. Fees must be paid before taking the exams. Presentations cannot be postponed and can only be made-up ahead of time (no fee in such a case).

### 5.3 Make-up Exams for Cantonese Students 廣東話學生補考須知

#### (a) Quizzes/ Dictations 小測/聽寫

Dictations and quizzes cannot be made up. The scores for the absent dictations/ quizzes will be zero.

**(b) Mid-term Written Tests 期中筆試**

A student who misses the periodically scheduled test should apply for a make-up test within one week from the day he/ she returns to school. All grades earned from make-up arrangement will be reduced by 20%.

**(c) Mid-term Oral Test 期中口試**

All students who miss the mid-term oral test must attend the make-up test on the day assigned by the Division Head. If a student who could not take the make-up test on the designated day, his/ her mark for that test will be “zero”.

**(d) Final Oral and Written Exam 期末口試及筆試**

HK\$500 and HK\$300 will be charged respectively for each oral and written final exam taken after regular exam time. Postponed oral and written exams must be completed within or before the first week of the following term and will be graded 20% lower. Fees must be paid before taking the exams.

因涉及行政資源，任何學生要求提前或延後的期末考試須額外收費，口試收 HK\$500，筆試收 HK\$300，費用應在補考前繳交。延後的期末口試或筆試應在下學期的首周或之前補考，所有補考最高成績為正常分數的 80%。

**(e) Approval of Exam Date Changes 改期考試的批准**

Application for advancing or postponement of term exam date requires prior approval of the Division Head.

## **VI. Credits, Awards and Certificates 第六部份：學分、資歷等級及證書**

### **6.1 External credits transfer and transcript 外部學分互認及成績證明書**

CLC gives credits according to the University's regulations. Study at CLC has been recognized by major universities in the world for programme credit. Transfer of credits to other universities, however, is automatic only if the student comes to CLC as an exchange student arranged by the Chinese University (See website for more information: [www.cuhk.edu.hk/oal](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/oal) and [www.cuhk.edu.hk/jas/english/menu\\_eng.html](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/jas/english/menu_eng.html)). Applicants who are not exchange students and seeking credit transfer should consult their home institution first for such a possibility before enrolling to CLC programme.

本所按照大學規定給予學分，學分得到世界主要大學的承認，惟在本所修讀的中大交換生，其學分才會由中大自動轉到其他大學（參見：<http://www.oal.cuhk.edu.hk/>，[http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/jas/english/menu\\_eng.html](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/jas/english/menu_eng.html)），申請者若不是交換生應在報讀本所課程前先諮詢所屬院校是否承認學分。

For students from institutions that do not use a credit system, they can apply for transcripts with a small fee from the Centre. The transcript is prepared in sufficient details to present a clear picture of the work completed by each student. The students will be required to fill in a form indicating where to send the transcript to.

對於來自採用非學分制度院校的學生，本所可簽發附有詳細說明的成績證明書，解釋課程內容。學生若希望向其他院校呈交其在本所修習課程的表現報告，必須填寫相關表格及繳交費用。

## 6.2 Grade Report and Certificate of Attendance 成績單及出席證明

Each student is entitled to a Grade Report upon completion of a term's study. The Grade Report will be ready one month after a school term ends. It will be sent by regular post to students based on the mailing label affixed to the re-enrolment form filled in by the students. If continuing students forget to fill in the mailing label, The General Office will ask the student to pick up the grade report in person during the first week of the next school term. For students who discontinue the study and has forgotten filling in the mailing label, the General Office will send the Grade Report based on the address shown in the student record during the first week of the next school term. 學生修畢一學期後可獲發成績單。成績單通常在學期結束後一個月左右準備好，本所按學生在續讀意向表上郵寄標籤以平郵郵寄成績單予學生。若續讀生忘記填寫該欄，辦公室將在下學期開學時通知親臨辦公室領取。至於忘記填寫該欄的退學學生，辦公室將在下學期開學一週後以平郵按學生記錄上的地址郵寄成績單。

Certification of Attendance can also be provided upon request at a small fee to those whose attendance rate is 70% or above. 在出席率達七成的情況下，學生可付費申請「出席證明」。

## 6.3 Other certifying documents 其他證明文件

Some students may need certifying letter and/ or reference letter. Students are reminded to forward application to the general office and pay a small fee first, before making reference letter request to the teacher concerned. For students who need CLC to justify your grant and loan application in your home country, please allow at least 3 working days for processing and a fee is needed per document. 學生需要其他證明文件或推薦信之類時，請先向辦公室索取申請表及付費，然後才向有關老師提出撰寫推薦信的請求。若學生需要向母國申請助學金或貸款，而要求本所作出證明時，請預留三個工作日讓本所處理文件，收費按文件計。

## 6.4 Award-bearing Certificates 資歷證書

### 6.4.1 CLC Award-bearing Programmes CLC 資歷課程

CUHK-CLC is offering 14 award-bearing programmes in which eight are attainable by part-time study and six by daytime intensive study. The maximum duration of study for Advanced Diploma, Diploma and Certificate programme are 5 years, 3 years and 2 years respectively.

The principles adopted by the authority in conferring an award to students who studied the daytime intensive programmes are as follow:

- Finished studying the minimum credits 修讀足夠學分
- The maximum duration of study for Advanced Diploma, Diploma and Certificate programme are 5 years, 3 years and 2 years respectively. 高等文憑課程、文憑課程及證書課程最長修習期限分別為5年、3年及2年。

##### (b) Level attained 達到程度

- Minimum level attained by award recipient 資歷證書持有人之最低程度
- Students should take the compulsory courses assigned by the DH and pass in the graduation examination in order to get the Advanced Diploma award. 高等文憑學生須修畢必修科(由組長指定)並在畢業考試中合格方能獲取高等文憑資歷證書

##### (c) Attendance 出席情況

- Attain a minimum 70% attendance in every school term 每學期達七成或以上出席率

##### (d) Result and classes 成績及等級

- Those who are eligible to CUHK-CLC award will be further divided into different classes based on the following criteria. The class division will be printed on the certificate. 本所將按合資格獲得中大本所之資歷證明書者的成績，細分為不同等級，此等級將列印在證書上，頒發等級之標準如下：

- ♦ Award of Distinction: Strict adherence to the overall GPA threshold for Distinction 3.50-4.00 (A- to A). 「優異等級」：最低 GPA 3.50-4.00 (A- 至 A)
- ♦ Award of Merit: Strict adherence to the overall GPA threshold for Merit is 3.00-3.49 (B to B+). 「良好等級」：最低 GPA 3.00-3.49 (B 至 B+)
- ♦ Award (Pass): Overall GPA 1.0-2.99 (B- to D) or below. 「及格」：持 GPA 1.0-2.99 (B-至 D)
- ♦ Overall GPA below 1.0 (D) will not be given a certificate. GPA 1.0 (D) 以下者不會獲得任何中大資歷證書

#### 6.4.3 Award Certificate issuing reminder 資歷證書頒發注意事項

- ✧ The certificate issuing starts immediately after the student making application for the study deposit reclaim based on the level the student attained by the time when he/ she withdraw the deposit. The Centre will send the Award Certificate by register post within 3 months after the last studied term to the address the student wrote on the last re-enrolment form in which the application for deposit reclaim is indicated. Please make sure the address written is valid. The Centre takes no responsibility for any postal fault due to invalid address. 學生申請退還按金時，本所同時為學生申請發出證書，該證書將按學生最終程度及本所要求發出。本所將在學期結束後三個月內，按學生在續讀意向表申請退按金所示的地址，寄上資歷證書。請確保地址正確，本所不會就郵誤承擔責任。
- ✧ If a student wants to continue his/ her study with some semester breaks in between, he/ she should not withdraw the deposit. Otherwise, a student could not get the higher level certificate in the same programme. 若學生在某些學期休學，但仍打算繼續升學的話，便不應申請退還按金，否則便無法得到同科目更高程度的證書。
- ✧ If a leaving student does not withdraw the deposit within 3 years, the certificate will be issued to the student by that time based on his/ her highest level attained for that subject. 若離校學生在三年內未申請退還按金，本所將在三年期滿時按學生最後的程度發出相關資歷證書。
- ✧ To carry through the spirit of life-long learning and continuing education, a student can study the different programmes of the same languages, or to study the same programme for more than once and to get award certificates. Conditions apply. 為貫徹終身學習及持續進修的精神，本所容許學生在符合條件下修讀同一語言的不同課程，或是修同一個課程超過一次並獲得多張證書。
- ✧ A completed student may apply for a replacement certificate in case of loss or damage of an original certificate. Supporting document and a fee are necessary. Application for replacement due to change of name after graduation will not be accepted. 結業生因證書遺失或損毀可向本所申請補領證書，須提供證明文件及繳交手續費。因學生結業後改名的原因申請證書補領將不獲接納。

## VII. Chinese Language Benchmarking Exams 第七部份：漢語基準試

### Introduction 引言

There are various frequently used Chinese language benchmarking tests in Hong Kong and world-wide. To name some, COPA, HSK and PSC etc. As a major international language training centre, CLC offers language-related services such as proficiency assessment in both Cantonese and Putonghua, in addition to its major tasks of teaching and publication of teaching materials and dictionaries. Currently, CLC is the official test centre for COPA, BCT and HSK. Except for these three exams, the Centre will not coordinate students' registration of the benchmarking exams. Students should forward application on their own. Information will be posted to the bulletin board. Briefing on Chinese language benchmarking exams is held by CLC from time to time. 坊間有多個常用的漢語基準試，例：COPA, HSK 及 PSC 等等。研習所作為國際語言培訓單位，除為大學生及社區提供語言訓練、出版教材和字典外，也為社會提供普通話和廣東話口語能力標準化測試服務。研習所是 COPA, BCT 及 HSK 的認可考點，這三個考試以外，本所暫未能提供代辦報考其他語文基準試的服務，有需要之同學請自行辦理。考試信息將張貼在告示板，研習所定期舉辦漢語水平考試的簡介會。

### 7.1 COPA (Computerized Oral Proficiency Assessment) 電腦口語水平評核

Introduction: The COPA assesses the oral proficiency of learners of Putonghua and Cantonese for communication purposes for both native and non-native Chinese speakers. It follows similar testing principles used in the Chinese Speaking Test (CST), an on-going research project funded by the US Department of Education. The COPA rating scale is



built upon the proficiency guidelines developed by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL). 簡介: COPA 以溝通為最終目的, 測試母語及非母語人士學習普通話或粵語的口語水平。COPA 根據美國教育部資助下的漢語模擬口語水平面試 (CST) 的原則及美國外語教學委員會口語水平大綱制定。

## 7.2 HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi) 漢語水平考試

Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (HSK or Chinese Proficiency Test) is the most popular standardized test of standard Chinese language proficiency for non-native speakers. Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) authorized CLC as one of the test centres in Hong Kong. The 2020 test date is December 6 respectively. On the other hand, HSK preparation courses are held from time to time in the Centre.

## 9.3 Financial Aids 進修資助

### 9.3.1. Continuing Education Fund 持續進修基金(CEF)

[The Continuing Education Fund \(CEF\)](#) is a HKSAR government initiative to subsidize local adult residents with learning aspirations in pursuing continuing education and training courses. Various CLC programmes have been added into the list of reimbursable courses for Continuing Education Fund purposes. Students who fulfilled the following requirement can consider applying for CEF to fund partly their study programme. Eligible students are entitled to 60-80% refund on course fee with a ceiling of HK\$20000 per person in a lifetime (for courses opened on or after 1 April 2019).

持續進修基金(CEF)是香港特區政府為有志進修的成年居港人士提供持續教育和培訓資助。本所有數個課程獲批准加入 CEF 可獲發還款項課程內，學生符合以下要求可考慮申請 CEF 資助他們的研修，合資格者可獲發還有關課程費用的 60-80%或上限每人 20,000 港元(適用於 2019 年4 月1 日或之後開課的課程)。

#### A. Identity 身份

The students should be:

1. Hong Kong residents who have the right of abode or the right to land or to remain in Hong Kong without restriction, i.e. “A” (right of abode), “R” (right to land) or “U” (remain in Hong Kong without restriction) should appear below the date of birth on the HK Smart ID card. For details of the meaning of symbols, please visit the website of the Immigration Department <http://www.immd.gov.hk>. Holders of one-way permits from Mainland China may also apply;

#### **9.3.2. Extended Non-means-tested Loan Scheme 延伸的免入息審查貸款計劃 (ENLS)**

The Extended Non-means-tested Loan Scheme (ENLS) provides financial assistance in the form of loan(s) to eligible students to settle tuition fees of specific post-secondary / continuing and professional education courses studied in Hong Kong. The scheme is administered by the Student Finance Office, Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency (WFSFAA) of the HKSAR Government. Scheme application is opened all year round. All of the CUHK-CLC award-bearing programmes (daytime intensive programmes and part-time programmes, from QF level 2 to level 4) are eligible for assistance under the scheme.

Please note that only those with right of abode in Hong Kong are eligible for this scheme. Student visa holder is not accepted. The loan is interest-bearing and a strict repayment scheme applies. ### **9.3.3. Tax Deduction for Expenses of Self-Education 「個人進修開支」扣稅**

Students pursuing a course at CUHK-CLC to gain or maintain qualifications for use in either the current or a planned employment are eligible to apply for the tax deduction in respect of the course (tuition fee, textbooks and materials, examination fees etc.). Students should take good care of the official receipt and submit together if requested in the annual tax return exercise with Inland Revenue Department. The upper limit for amount deduction, depends on fiscal year, is HK\$40,000 to HK\$60,000 per year.

### 9.3.5. Regulation governing the use of discount and subsidy 關於使用折扣及資助的規定

Special subsidy on tuition fee is available to CUHK staff and spouse. Besides, concession on tuition fee is available to CUHK/ CLC alumni, spouse and children all year round. Discount is sometimes given in conjunction of designated promotional event. All discounts are subject to quota. According to CUHK policy and to avoid double subsidy, staff who apply for staff training expense reimbursement should not take the special subsidy on tuition fee offered by CLC. Students are advised not to apply for other funding if they are going to get reimbursement from the Continuing Education Fund.

Discount is only considered on a per course per term basis subject to quota. Students should not assume the discount can be automatically carried forward to the next school term. As CLC have no direct access to the CUHK staff, student and graduate database, students applying for discount should provide valid proof to their identity.

## X. Health Care and Medical Service 第十部份：醫療及保健

Due to change in water, food, and climate, students may experience discomfort after they arrive in Hong Kong. It is strongly advised that students to pay close attention to their health and diet during their stay here. Students are strongly encouraged to buy medical insurance for their whole course of stay in Hong Kong.

The University clinic is NOT opened to CLC students. However, holders of HKID, student visa, working visa or dependent visa are entitled to local resident rate in public clinics and hospitals during visa effective period. Reference rate:

Alternatively, students can visit private doctors in hospitals or clinics. A consultation fee with prescription roughly charges HK\$250-350 per visit by general physicians and HK\$700-900 by specialists. Hospitalisation (semi-private room and board) is charged HK\$600-700 per day.

For emergencies, please seek prompt treatment at the Accident and Emergency unit of government hospitals. **For ambulance and life-threatening emergencies, dial 999**, the emergency hotline.

For protection against influenza, students are reminded to be vigilant and observe good personal and environmental hygiene.

- Consult doctors promptly if any symptoms of respiratory tract infection develop, and wear a mask (available for sale at CLC office, HK\$1.0 each).
- Proper hand washing is an effective hygiene practice to avoid contracting and spreading communicable diseases.
- Avoid going to crowded places and if the ventilation is poor, wear a mask to protect yourself and others.
- Build up body immunity by proper diet, exercise, adequate rest and avoid smoking.

學生來港後可能會因水土不服而感覺不適，所以留港期間，要注意身體健康及飲食。本所建議學生在港留學階段預先購買醫療保險。

- 避免前往人煙稠密的地方，如果室內空氣不流通，請帶上口罩，注意自己及他人的健康；及
- 注意均衡飲食、定時運動、充足休息和避免吸煙，以增強身體的抵抗力。

## **XI. Facilities      第十一部份：設施**

CLC continuing education students CANNOT use the facilities and services (including the University Health Service) which require the access of CUHK Link Card, a digital personal data card for CUHK staff and Hong Kong government subsidized CUHK undergraduate and postgraduate students. Services that are opened to CLC students are shown below.

### **11.1 Language Laboratory 語言實習室**

The Centre has a language laboratory (Room G07, Fong Shu Chuen Building) with audio and video facilities and computer terminals. Please refer to section 1.2 for operation hours. 本所設有語言實習室(方樹泉樓 G07)，提供影音及電腦設施予學生，開放時間請參 1.2。

### **11.2 Parking 泊車**

Students who frequently drive to the Centre to attend class can buy parking coupons @HK\$20, good for 5-hour parking. Application forms for buying parking coupons are obtainable at CLC General Office. Parking coupons are sold at the Security Unit near the main University entrance. The University may impound illegally parked vehicles and impose a retrieval charge on the owner.

### **11.3 University Buses 校巴**

Large University buses for commuting around the campus are free of charge for student/staff ID card holder all year round. Buses run frequently to and from the University Station. Minibuses (capacity at 16 persons) are also available at 30 minute intervals running from the station at HK\$4.50 per trip. Exact timetables are available at the CLC General Office.

## 11.5 Universities Service Centre for China Studies 中國研究服務中心

The Universities Service Centre for China Studies (USC) in the Tin Ka Ping Building provides a comprehensive, user-friendly collection of original source materials on contemporary China for scholars all over the world. The USC's library on post-1949 China is incomparable in its coverage: complete runs from the early 1950s up to the present of most of China's provincial and national newspapers; a collection of provincial yearbooks; many hundreds of county gazetteers; and a judiciously chosen collection of the most valuable books available on the mainland, many of which are unavailable elsewhere in the world. Currently USC subscribes to 2,000 magazines in Chinese and over 80 in English, and to more than 400 Chinese newspapers. USC is committed to serving scholars in contemporary China studies everywhere. Local as well as overseas researchers are eligible to use the centre free of charge. USC also organizes luncheon seminars on China studies, and runs a mainland visiting scholar scheme. Its missions include creating the best research environment, facilitating exchange between local and international scholars, and promoting social responsibility among academics.

位於田家炳樓的中國研究服務中心專門收集關於中國大陸的研究資料，其度藏之豐富及使用之方便，著稱於國際中國研究學術圈。該中心藏有大陸五十年代初期至今之全國性報章及各省省報，而地方報紙、雜誌、地方年鑑、統計資料、新編地方誌等收藏之完善，為當代中國研究圖書館之冠。中心訂有內地報紙三百多種，中文期刊近兩千種和英文雜誌八十餘種。現有中英文藏書八萬餘冊。從事中國研究的專業人士及學生，不論國別與地區，均可使用該中心的設施。中心經常舉辦中國研究的午餐研討會，並主持內地學人訪問計劃。中心的宗旨是營造最佳學術研究環境，促進中外學者交流，提倡研究為社會服務。

## 11.6 Sports Facilities 康體設施

CUHK sports fields, the University Gymnasium (The University Sports Centre) and the CUHK swimming pool are opened to CLC students by producing the CLC student card. Some of the amenities require a small fee. Application for CUHK fitness room user card is necessary before using the CUHK fitness room. Students can also consider using the public sports facilities provided by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department of the HKSAR government.

The closest ones to CLC Fong Shu Chuen Building are Chung Chi Canteen, Cafes in Cheng Yu Tung Building and S. H. Ho College Canteen. A couple of light meal shops can be found near to the University train station. Some students may also find taking a train to Taipo station is a good alternative. ## 11.9 Banking 銀行

There are two banks in CUHK. Hang Seng Bank, located at John Fulton Centre (H29 on the campus map) and East Asia Bank, located at Pommerenke Student Centre (Chung Chi Campus) offer full-fledged of banking services. ATM machines are also available inside the Kowloon bound exit and outside Lowu bound exit of the University Station. ### 11.10 Groceries 雜貨店

A Park'n Shop mini-grocery is on the lower ground floor of the John Fulton Centre (H29 on the campus map). Open from 8:30AM through 9:00PM. It carries a range of fresh and processed foods, and variety items from toothpaste to screwdrivers. 百佳超級市場在富爾敦樓地下底層，除了提供日常用品，還有各種新鮮食物及副食品。營業時間是上午八時三十分至晚上九時。

### 11.11 Bookstore 書店

The University Bookstore run by Commercial Press HK is located at the first floor of Yasumoto Academic Park just opposite to Fong Yun Wah Hall. Books in Chinese and English, together with stationery, are sold there. 大學書店由商務印香港代理，位於方潤華堂對面的康本國際學術園一樓，中英文書籍及文具有售。

### 11.12 Souvenir Shop 紀念品店

Located at the ground floor of the John Fulton Centre is the university souvenir shop, selling complete series of CUHK mementos, such as pens, umbrellas and paperweights etc. CLC souvenirs can be purchased at CLC general office counter. 在富爾敦樓地下的中文大學紀念品店，售賣中文大學一系列的紀念品，包括筆、雨傘、紙鎮等等。本所的紀念品可在辦公室購買。

### 11.13 Post Office 郵局

The nearest post office to the university is located in the Shatin Government Building near to the Shatin Station. ### **12.1 Student I.D. Card 學生證**

CLC students are eligible to apply for a student I.D. card at the CLC General Office. This card will entitle students to use various CUHK amenities at student price. In case of loss, please report to CLC immediately. A charge will be levied for replacement. Students are required to return I.D. cards for refunding of deposits. 本所學生可向辦公室申請學生證。如有遺失，請立即通知本所。補領新證需徵收費用。學生必須退還學生證才可取回按金。

### **12.2 Library Card 圖書證**

CLC students should obtain a library card first before using the library facilities of the University. Applications must be processed within the first week of a school term by paying a card fee of HK\$100 per year and to submit an electronic photo. In case of loss, report immediately to CLC. Students are required to return the library cards for refunding of their deposits. ### **12.3 Campus WiFi Access 使用校內無線寬頻網絡**

For students who study 12 credits or above in a school term, they can apply for a CUHK WiFi guest account for wireless internet access on campus. Eligible students can make request at the CLC service counter. The closest WiFi access to the Centre is located at G/F of Yasumoto International Academic Park (opposite to Fong Yun Wah Hall).
